

POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS

(a) A unit owner may display a sign supporting a political candidate in one window of the unit. The sign may not be larger than 9 x 11 inches and can only be displayed no more than thirty days prior to the election in which said candidate is participating. The sign shall be removed within three (3) days of the election being over.

(3) (a) An association may not refuse the request of a unit owner for a reasonable accommodation for the attachment on the mantel or frame of the door of the unit owner of a religious object not to exceed 3 inches wide, 6 inches high, and 1.5 inches deep.

(b) A unit owner may display in one window of the unit, a sign supporting a political candidate. The sign may not be larger than 9 x 11 inches and can only be displayed no more than thirty days prior to the election in which said candidate is participating. The sign shall be removed within three (3) days of the election being over.

(6) (a) A homeowner association may not refuse the request of a unit owner for a reasonable accommodation for the attachment on the mantel or frame of the door of the unit owner of a religious object not to exceed 3 inches wide, 6 inches high, and 1.5 inches deep.

(b) A homeowner may display in one window of the home, and any lawn area owned by the homeowner, a sign supporting a political candidate. The window sign may not be larger than 9 x 11 inches. The lawn sign may not be larger than 11 x 14 inches and each can only be displayed no more than thirty days prior to the election in which said candidate is participating. The sign shall be removed within three (3) days of the election being over.
